About the show

Florence has a little white dog, a trolley full of tricks and a no-nonsense attitude. When visitors come to her care home, she's the first on the scene and the most in the know. So, when (over-enthusiastic) Geoff the armchair fitness instructor, (over-pompous) Maurice the chef de cuisine and (overly clean) Keith the window cleaner arrive ready for work, Florence is waiting in the wings to disrupt their day.

Love Through Double Glazing is written and performed by Cirque du Soleil clown performer Sean Kempton, Vamos Theatre Artistic Director Rachael Savage, and emerging artist, Norah the fluffy white dog.



A few things to make the show even better!

- Norah, our performing dog, can get so distracted if she sees a cat. Keep your lovely pets out of sight for the performance
- There will be lots of playful mess, but don't worry, we will clean it all up. We just need a working outside tap
- Along with the dancing, storytelling and acrobatics, there will be lots of music. We'll pass a Covid-safe Bluetooth speaker through a downstairs window to you before the start
- We want everyone to join in, so we may bring along some Covid-safe props to share before the show begins
