Mask Making is a great way for students to really understand character in an engaging, hands-on, creative process. Suitable for any ability, with no special art skills needed, up to 16 students can learn how to make their own masks, from deciding character through to the finished item. Choose any length from 1 day to a 5 day residency.
